High hopes are with our British Stars because amongst our many male and female medal winning champs, making up some of the best in the world across all divisions, is Princes Club's own Nick Davies, aged 20 from Chertsey, who has taken the world by storm this year blowing away all other competition with Judges just chucking their scoring sheets away with everyone one of his contest winning runs!
